### The After-Care Corner

The After-Care Program (“ACP”) at JMS is a PTO-sponsored program – so all money goes right back to the PTO which benefits the school, as well as your children.

A typical day after school begins in the cafeteria at 4 p.m. The children are served a hot meal by the cafeteria staff. Teachers encourage the children to begin working on their homework at this time. At 4:45, they head over to the library where they can finish their homework and have some computer time. Parents are allowed to park outside of the library to pick up their children, which makes it nice so the parents don’t have to walk very far.
